



## **Dublinia Everest Challenge – Guidelines**

### **AIM:**

- To promote hiking as an activity & to increase mountain skills within the Dublinia Scout County.

### **Supporting Activities/Badges:**

Mountain Pursuit Challenge/Sionnach  
SUMMIT  
Peak  
Sluaíocht na Sléibhte  
Get Out  
Hiker/Hike Leader/Hill Walker.

### **Requirements:**

- Be a Scout or Venturer.
- Over a period of time (aim for a year) a scout must climb a number of peaks which, together, total the height of Mount Everest (29035ft / 8850m).
- Make note of the various peaks climbed, dates & heights on your personal record card.
- When your peaks have reached the combined height of Mt. Everest, please return your card to the challenge coordinator or C.P.C. to receive your award.
- Each peak should only be used once.
- Don't forget to get your scout leader to verify the card.

### **Award:**

- Dublinia Everest Badge, (to be worn over right side breast pocket).
- Groups may issue certificates for height climbed at their own discretion, logos etc. can be obtained from the County Commissioner.

### **Notes:**

- Everyone should be able to achieve this award.
- Supporting material, personal record cards, posters will be available from 14<sup>th</sup> January 2008.
- Heights climbed may be backdated to 1<sup>st</sup> September 2007.
